## The following changes apply to both Windows<sup>®</sup> and Macintosh<sup>®</sup> printer drivers.

Super option provided in addition to the MicroWeave setting

The Super (MicroWeave) check box has been added to the More Settings Dialog box, as shown below. This feature is enabled when Print Quality is set to SuperFine - 1440dpi. Select Super if your printout has banding problems even with MicroWeave turned on. Be aware that printing time may increase when Super is selected.

To restart printing, click the document, and click at the top of the dialog box.

To cancel a print job, click the document, and click **1** at the top of the dialog box.

To prioritize print jobs in a print queue, follows the steps below.

1. Click the Show details arrow at the bottom of the dialog box. You will see an extended dialog box similar to the one below.
