Opening the Online Guides

For Windows

- 1. Insert the online guide CD in your CD-ROM drive.
- The dialog box on the right appears. If it does not, doubleclick the My Computer icon, click the CD-ROM icon, then select Open from the File menu. Then double-click ESS2500.exe.



3. Click the appropriate **View** button to open the guide of your choice.


To install the Reference Guide on your hard disk, click **Install Reference Guide** and follow the on-screen instructions. When the installation is complete, a **ESS2500 Guide** icon appears in the EPSON folder. Double-click the icon to open the guide.

For Macintosh

- 1. Insert the online guide CD in your CD-ROM drive.
- Double-click EPSON STYLUS SCAN 2500. The dialog box on the right appears.
- Click the appropriate View button to open the guide of your choice.



To install the Reference Guide on your hard disk, click **Install Reference Guide** and follow the on-screen instructions. When the installation is complete, a **View Reference Guide** icon appears in the EPSON STYLUS SCAN 2500 folder. Double-click the icon to open the guide.

For Windows

- Insert the online guide CD in your CD-ROM drive. If a dialog box appears with options to view or install the guides, click Quit.
- Double-click the My Computer icon, click the CD-ROM icon, then select Open from the File menu.
- Double-click the Browser folder.
- 4. Double-click Win95nt then double-click le.
- Double-click ie5setup.exe (the number may vary by version) for Windows 95/ 98 and follow the on-screen instructions.

For Macintosh

- 1. Insert the online guide CD in your CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Double-click the Browser folder.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to install Internet Explorer.
