To install the Reference Guide on your hard disk, click **Install Reference Guide** and follow the on-screen instructions. When installation is complete, a Reference Guide icon appears in the EPSON folder. Double-click the icon to open the guide.

## For Windows

Note for Windows NT 4.0 users:

Before installing Microsoft Internet Explorer, you need to install the Windows NT Service Pack 3 or later.

- 1. Insert the online guide CD in your CD-ROM drive. If a dialog box appears with options to view or install the guides, click **Quit**.
- 2. Double-click the **My Computer** icon, then double-click the CD-ROM icon. For Windows 3.1, click the CD-ROM drive in File Manager.
- 3. Double-click the **Browser** folder.
- 4. For Windows 95 or NT 4.0: double-click **Win95nt** then double-click **Ie**.
- 5. Double-click **ie5setup.exe** (the number may vary by version) for Windows 95 or NT 4.0 and follow the onscreen instructions.

## For Macintosh

- 1. Insert the online guide CD in your CD-ROM drive.
- 2. Double-click the **Browser** folder.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to install Internet Explorer.
