

Adjusting the Image Size



User's Guide "Screen Size and Projection Distance"

The size of the projected image is basically determined by the distance from the projector to the screen. The values should be used as a guide for setting up the projector.




^{*} When installing against a wall, leave about 20 cm (7.9 in.) between the projector and the wall.

Connecting to a Computer

Turn off the power for both the projector and the computer before connecting them.






The computer cable supplied with the projector may not match the monitor port on some computers. In such cases, you will need to purchase a separate adapter.

Connecting to a Video Source

Turn off the power for both the projector and the video source before connecting them.





If connecting a component video source (such as a DVD player), you can use the optional component video cable to connect the source to the Computer/Component Video port at the left of the projector.

- 1 Remove the lens cover.
- 2 Inert the projector's power cable into the projector.
- 3 Insert the power cable into an earthed electrical outlet.

The Power indicator will light orange.

Turn on the power for the signal input source.


For video equipment, press [Play] to start playback.

Press to turn on the projector's power.

The Power indicator will flash green, and projection will then start (warm-up in progress).



• If no images appear, change the input source.






Remote control


Adjustments



Adjusting the image angle

While pressing the foot adjust buttons at either side, lift up the front of the projector.

When the desired angle is obtained, release the foot adjust buttons.




Foot adjust button

Fine adjustments to image size


Press [Zoom] on the control panel to the "W" to increase the image size, and to the "T" to reduce the image size.





If the images have keystone distortion

Press [Keystone] on the projector's control panel to correct keystone distortion.





The following adjustments can also be made.


• Automatic setup (only when computer images are projected)


When projecting computer images, the input signals are detected automatically and adjusted so that the optimum images are projected. If the results of automatic adjustment are not satisfactory, individual settings can also be adjusted manually using the menus.

Other adjustments (User's Guide "Using the Configuration Menu Functions"
 Press [Menu] on the remote control to display the configuration menu. You can use the menu functions to adjust settings such as brightness, contrast and colour.

Turning Off the Projector




- 1 Turn off the power for all sources connected to the projector.
- Press (b) twice to turn off the power.
 The Power indicator will flash orange (cool-down in progress/about 20 seconds).
- 3 Check that the Power indicator lights orange, and then disconnect the power cable from the electrical outlet.

Using the help function

- on the projector's control panel.
- Select the item to view.


Press [▼ Select ▲] (or the [▲] and [▼] on the remote control).

3 Accept the selection.

Press [Enter] on the control panel or on the remote control.

The help contents will then be displayed.

To clear the display, press on the control panel.


